OCA EDUCATION PROJECTS FUNDING APPLICATION SCHEME 1 September 2017

Scheme for the giving of annual awards to former pupils of Caterham School to support them in research and other university projects which they may undertake as part of their studies.

The OCA will assist former pupils through the giving of monetary awards to support education projects undertaken by an Old Caterhamian.

The objectives of the scheme are to:

- To support exceptional past pupils in worthwhile education projects.
- To promote diversity and inclusion within the former pupil population.
- To support exceptional academic talent.

Applications will be open to those former Caterham School pupils who meet some or all of the following criteria:

- They have already demonstrated an excellent academic record;
- They or their family are unable to fund the project or are only able to part-fund it;
- On completion of the project they give a talk to relevant Sixth Form students on the project and the results, and agree to provide an interview and photographs in order that their project can be featured in relevant School publications.
- Applicants are bound to disclose any alternative sources of funding received for their project, including funding received following their application to the OCA.
- Applicants to the scheme who were in receipt of a bursary during their time at Caterham School are requested to include this information in support of their application.

Each year the OCA will donate up to a maximum of $\pm 2,500.00$ and no more than ± 500.00 will be awarded to the same individual.
