## ARCHIVIST'S REPORT

While my attendance at the School has not been possible because of the virus, a lot has been going on electronically, much of it in terms of refining the upgraded digital archive website. This is very attractive and works well.

Our attention has been concentrated on the photographs section, which has created a lot of interest among alumni, thanks to Annie's good work in posting photos for identification on Facebook.

The new website has also been enthusiastically explored by a group of pupils who have established a Junior History Society and have carried out a research project on John Townsend and William Wilberforce with an accompanying illustrated article published on the OCA website memories section.

Approximately 85% of the material supplied to our digitizing firm SDS has been processed and about 45% of that is online. A large collection of unidentified team photos is being painstakingly enquired about and annotated by David Rogers and will be supplied to SDS when restrictions are lifted, together with a collection of School, house and other group photos, all of which have been budgeted for.
